It is inert with outstanding biological, chemical and environmental resistance. HI FIBE 2000 is a uniform product offering good dispersibility, very low shrinkage on drying, and airless sprayability. In many applications HI FIBE 2000 can replace asbestos at one-tenth the asbestos concentration.
